## **Rathaus and Bürgerbüro**, Bismarckstraße 8

Opening hours:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday: 8:30 – 12:30

and Tuesday also: 14:30-18:00 Uhr3.

Wednesday: closed

Additional Opening hours for Bürgerbüro:

Thursday 14:30 - 18:00

**Infothek** is in 3<sup>rd</sup> floor (German counting: 2<sup>nd</sup> floor)

To Infothek you need to go, if you

- Need a Gesundheitskarte (don't forget to bring passport-photo of yourself and family members)
- want to get a Sozialpass (here you also need to bring a photo)
- need something for your flat
- at the end of month (two days before month end) for getting money for the next month
- and so on...
